STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to prohibit the Killing of Deer on Long Island.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from hunt-
2 ing or killing any deer on Long Island, in the town of Blue-
3 hill, in the county of Hancock, for the space of five years,
4 under the pains and penalties now prescribed by law for
5 hunting or killing deer in close time.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
