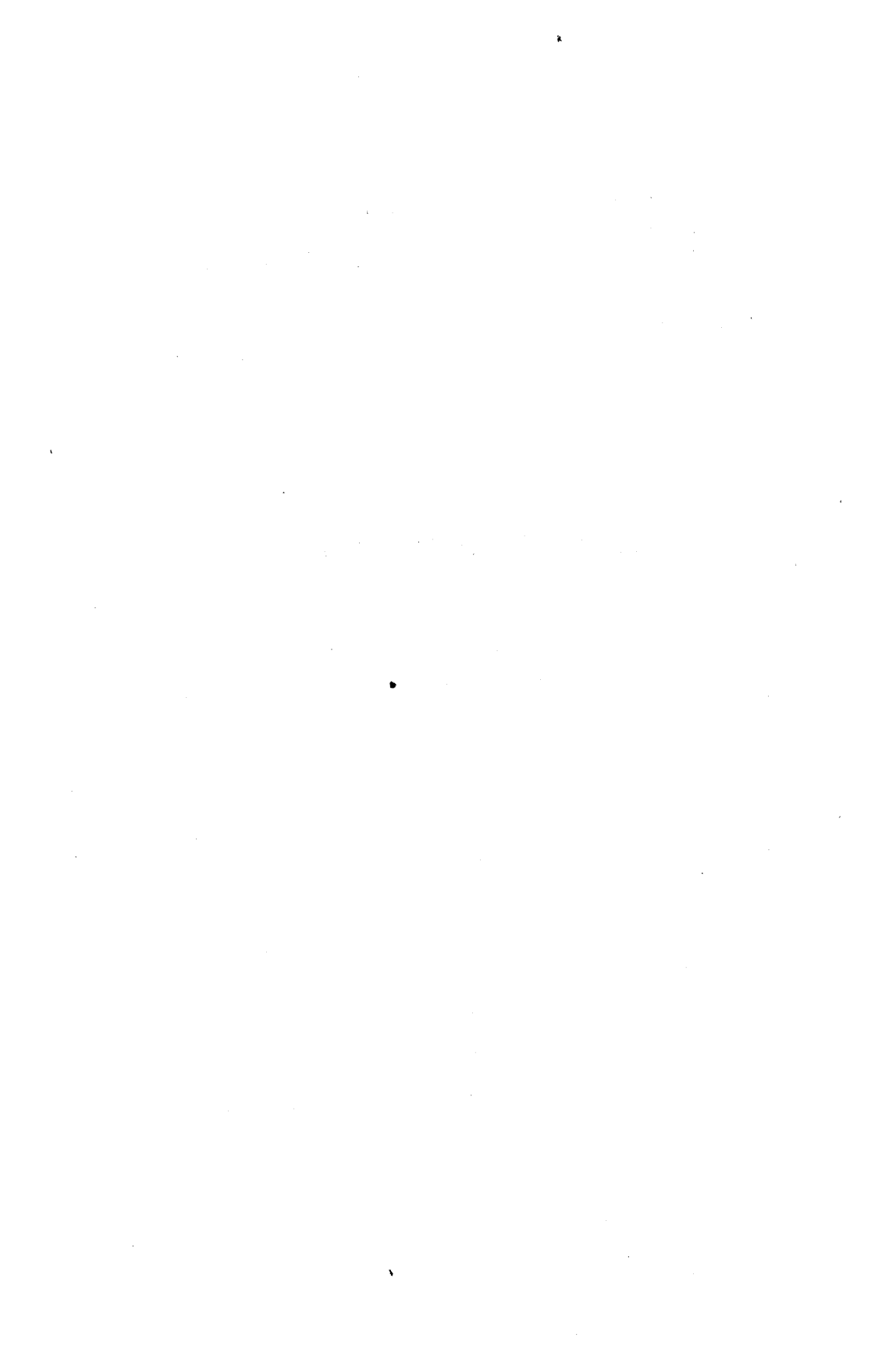

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of making necessary repairs in the Senate Chamber of the State Capitol.

Resolved, That the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars be
2 and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of recovering
3 the roof over the north wing of the State Capitol, removing
4 the ceiling in the Senate chamber, which has become
5 loosened and cracked in such a manner as to necessitate
6 its displacement, and to replaster, paint and decorate the
7 ceiling and walls, prior to the assembling of the next legis-
8 lature. The appropriation to be expended by the superin-
9 tendent of public buildings under the direction of the gov-
10 ernor and council.
