AN ACT additional relating to Hubbard Free Library of
Hallowell.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled; as follows:*

The several acts relating to the Hubbard Free Library of
2 Hallowell, formerly the "Hallowell Social Library" are
3 hereby amended, so that said library may take and hold real
4 and personal estate not exceeding one hundred thousand
5 dollars.
