STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT in relation to the Bath Military and Naval Orphan
Asylum.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section six of chapter one hundred and sixty-
2 three of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred
3 and sixty-six, as amended by chapter four hundred and five
4 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
5 ninety-three, is hereby amended by striking out all after the
6 word "of" in the seventh line and inserting in lieu thereof
7 the words 'poor and neglected orphan children residing in
8 this State,' so that said section shall read as follows:

'Section 6. Upon the final execution of the purpose here-
10 in specified as the object of this incorporation, viz: the sup-

11 port and education of the orphans and half orphans of
12 persons engaged in the service of the United States during
13 the recent rebellion, said asylum shall continue the exercise
14 of its corporate powers as an institution for the education
15 and support of poor and neglected orphan children residing
16 in this State.
