IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section eleven, chapter forty-six of the
Revised Statutes, relating to Clerks of Corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section eleven of chapter forty-six of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Whenever there is a change in the office of clerk of a cor-
4 poration, he shall, within twenty days after acceptance of
5 the office file a certificate of his election in the registry of
6 deeds in the district where the corporation is located, or
7 where it has a place of business or a general agent; and an
8 attested copy of such certificate shall be sufficient evidence
9 that he is clerk, for service of process upon the corporation,
10 until another certificate has been filed.
