STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend paragraph four (IV) of section six (6) of chapter six (6) of the Revised Statutes, relating to the taxation of estate and property of Religious Societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph four (IV) of section six (6) of chap-2 ter six (6) of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by 3 adding after the word "and" in the third line of said para-4 graph the word 'other,' and by striking out in the third 5 and fourth lines thereof the words "as a parsonage;" and 6 by striking out in the fourth and fifth lines thereof the 7 words "and from which no rent is received," so that said 8 paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

SENATE—No. 147.

'IV. Houses of religious worship, including vestries, 10 and the pews and furniture within the same, except for 11 parochial purposes; tombs and rights of burial; and other 12 property held by a religious society, not exceeding six 13 thousand dollars in value. But all other property of any 14 religious society, both real and personal, is liable to taxa-15 tion the same as other property.'
