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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to legalize the incorporation of Wales Grange, Num-  
ber Forty, Patrons of Husbandry.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The acts and doings of Wales grange, number  
2 forty, Patrons of Husbandry, at a meeting of said grange  
3 held June twentieth, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, for  
4 the purpose of organizing said grange into a corporate  
5 legal body, under chapter fifty-five of the Revised Statutes  
6 of Maine, so far as relates to insufficient notice and other  
7 informalities, are hereby legalized and made valid, and said  
8 grange is hereby declared to be a legal corporation.

Sect. 2. All the acts and doings of said corporation by  
2 its executive committee in issuing notes to create a fund  
3 to purchase flour and grain, and for the construction of its  
4 plant, so far as relates to any imperfection in the organiza-  
5 tion of said corporation, are hereby confirmed and declared  
6 legal and valid, but the contract rights of third persons are  
7 not hereby affected.

Sect. 3. All the acts and doings of said corporation in  
2 negotiating and securing a lease of a certain piece or parcel  
3 of land in the town of Wales, on which said corporation's  
4 buildings are located, of Alonzo L. Donnell, so far as relates  
5 to any imperfection in the organization of said corporation,  
6 are hereby legalized and made valid, but the contract  
7 rights of third persons are not hereby affected.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
