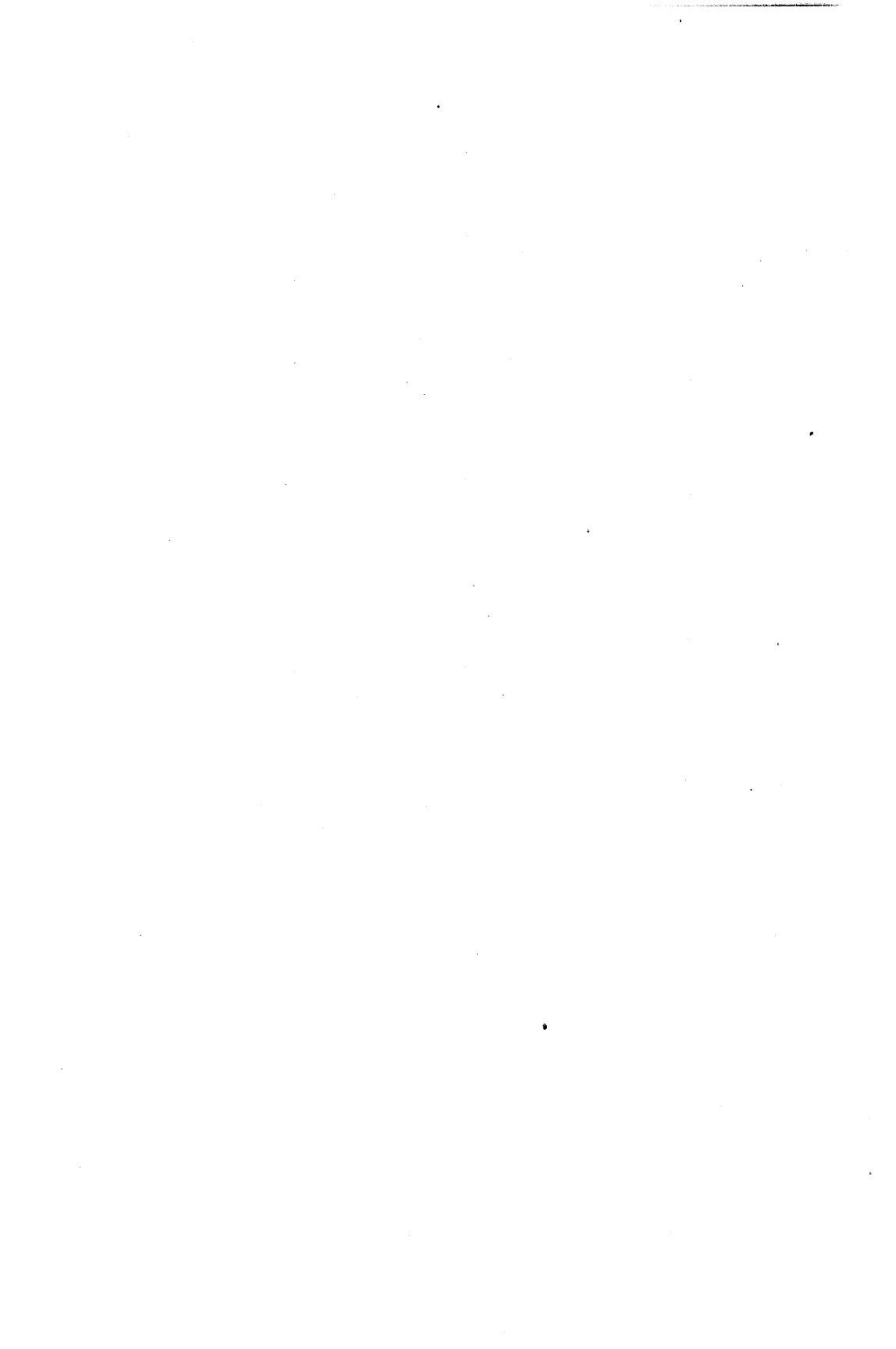
AN ACT to provide for procuring statistics relating to the
Poultry Industry in Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Assessors of cities, towns, and plantations,
2 when taking the inventory required to be taken on April
3 1, 1898, and on the first day of April of each fifth year
4 thereafter, shall enumerate the number of all kinds of
5 poultry, and forthwith return the same to the State
6 Assessors with their estimate of the value of the eggs
7 and poultry, stated separately, produced during the year
8 preceding; keeping their returns for each kind of poultry

9 separate and distinct. Said property shall not be included
10 in the tax list.

Sect. 2. The State Assessors shall tabulate said returns
2 and publish them in detail same as they now publish returns
3 of live stock.
