IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to further regulate Banking Hours on Saturdays  
which are not Bank Holidays.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Every Saturday, which is not a bank holi-  
2. day according to law, from twelve o'clock noon until  
3 twelve o'clock midnight shall, for all purposes whatever  
4 as regards the presenting for payment or acceptance and  
5 the protesting and giving notice of dishonor of bills of  
6 exchange, drafts, bank checks and promissory notes made  
7 after the passage of this act, be treated as and deemed a

8 half holiday; and all bills of exchange, drafts, bank  
9 checks and promissory notes which are liable to be pro-  
10 tested for non-acceptance or non-payment at twelve  
11 o'clock noon on any Saturday which is not a bank holiday  
12 according to law, may be protested for non-acceptance or  
13 non-payment, as the case may be, on any such Saturday  
14 at any time after twelve o'clock noon, or on the next suc-  
15 ceeding secular or business day.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect July one, eighteen  
2 hundred and ninety-seven.
