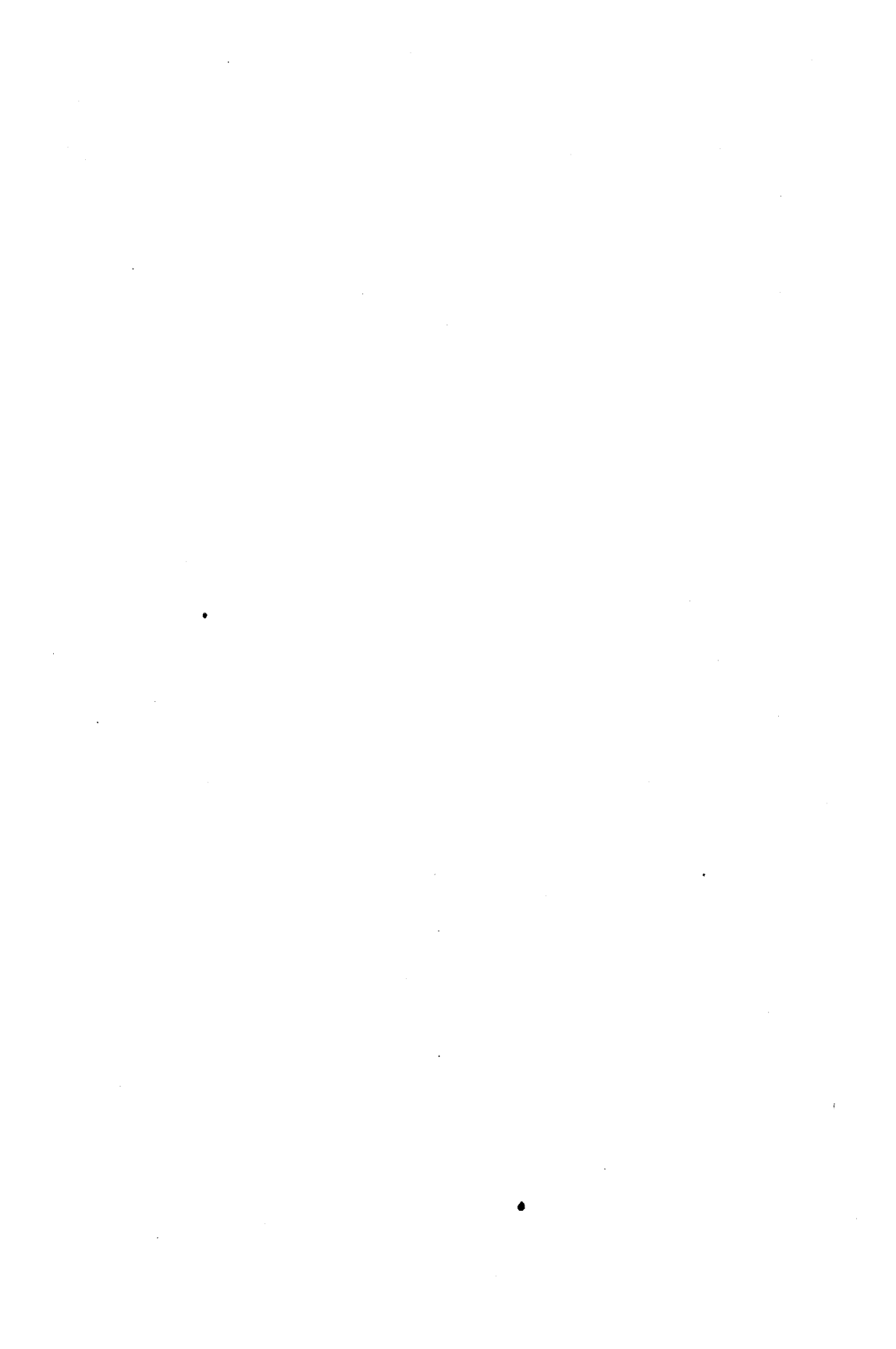
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to extend an act, entitled “An Act to supply the
people of South Gardiner Village in the City of Gardiner,
with pure water.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The charter granted to Sherburne Lawrence, Hiram
2 Lawrence, Charles Lawrence and Van R. Beedle and their
3 associates and successors, by chapter five hundred and
4 twenty-one of the Private and Special Laws of one thou-
5 sand eight hundred and ninety-three, to supply the people
6 of South Gardiner Village with pure water, is hereby
7 extended two years from the seventeenth day of March,
8 one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.
