STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section forty-seven of chapter seventy-seven of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and seventy-seven of the Public Laws of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, in relation to the time of holding the September term of the Supreme Judicial Court, Piscataquis county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter seventy-seven
2 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hun-
3 dred and seventy-seven of the Public Laws of the year
4 eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, is hereby amended com-
5 mencing at the eighth line from the bottom of the page, on

6 page six hundred and thirty-six, so that that part of said sec-
7 tion relating to the time of holding the terms of the supreme
8 judicial court in and for the county of Piscataquis shall
9 read as follows: 'Piscataquis, at Dover, on the last Tues-
10 day of February, and the third Tuesday of September.'

Sect. 2. All matters pending in, or returnable to said
2 court, and which would, but for the provisions of this act,
3 have day at the term of said court to be held on the fourth
4 Tuesday of September of the present year, as provided by
5 law, shall be returnable, and have day at the term of said court
6 to be held on the third Tuesday of September next.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect when
3 approved.
