STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 297 of the Private
and Special Laws of 1883, relating to dyke in town of Mil-
bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one of chapter two hundred and ninety-seven of the
2 Private and Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred
3 and eighty-three is hereby amended by striking out the
4 name Bartlett W. Brown in the first and second lines of said
5 section and inserting the name 'Jasper Wyman'; and
6 after the word, "others," in the ninth line adding the words,
7 'and to repair and maintain said old dyke,' so that said
8 section shall read when amended as follows:

‘Section 1. Joel G. Gay, Henry M. Leighton, Jasper
10 Wyman, William W. Blood, their associates, successors,
11 heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and main-
12 tain a good and sufficient dyke, at Back bay, in the town of
13 Milbridge, to commence at a point on the west side of Grain
14 point, so called, and to extend over tide waters across the
15 creek there situated, to land of Alonzo Fickett, in shore, of
16 the site of the old dyke formerly built across said creek by
17 the grantees of said Gay and others, and to repair and main-
18 tain said old dyke.’
