STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the purpose of repairing the Church of the
Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars
2 be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of repairing
3 the church of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, situated on
4 Indian island in the town of Old Town.

Said appropriation to be expended under the direction
6 of the agent of said Penobscot tribe.
