STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to amend section six of chapter one hundred and
thirty-two of the Public Laws of 1891, relating to punish-
ment for intoxication.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section six of chapter one hundred and thirty-two of the
2 Public Laws enacted in the year of our Lord eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-one is hereby so amended that the
4 punishment for the second or any subsequent conviction
5 for the offence of intoxication shall be by imprisonment
6 for not exceeding thirty days; instead of imprisonment
7 for thirty days as is by such section now provided.
