STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT to change the time of holding the October term of
the Supreme Judicial Court for the County of Waldo.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter seventy-seven
2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words “and the third Tuesdays of April and
4 October” in the thirty-second and thirty-third lines
5 thereof, and by inserting after the word “January” in the
6 thirty-second line, the words ‘and the third Tuesday of
7 April and the third Tuesday of September,’ so that said
8 lines as amended shall read as follows :

‘Waldo, at Belfast, on the first Tuesday of January, and
10 the third Tuesday of April, and the third Tuesday of
11 September.’
