STATE OF MAINE.

Senate Amendment A to House Document No. 270.

Amend by striking out all after title, and inserting the
2 following:

‘*Resolved*, That for the purpose of continuing the work
4 provided for by chapter eighteen of the resolves of 1895,
5 and completing certain portions thereof, the Governor and
6 Council are hereby directed to take immediate steps to con-
7 struct and complete in a manner to be fire proof, upon the
8 site named in said chapter, one pavilion for the accommoda-
9 tion of the insane of the State, and to complete, equip, and
10 furnish so far as necessary the buildings already commenced,
11 and for that purpose the sum of seventy-five thousand dol-
12 lars is hereby appropriated, to be expended during the year
13 one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, and one hun-

14 dred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be neces-
15 sary, during the year one thousand eight hundred and
16 ninety-eight, under the direction of the Governor and Coun-
17 cil as aforesaid. The Governor and Council may employ a
18 competent and experienced builder to superintend the work
19 of construction. The above amount, one hundred and
20 seventy-five thousand dollars, is to complete, equip and fur-
21 nish the buildings already begun and to include one pavilion;
22 and the total cost for all such buildings and furnishings,
23 when completed and ready for occupancy, shall not exceed
24 the amount of this appropriation.'
