STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-SEVEN

AN ACT relating to the transportation by Common Carriers,
of property, the title to which is disputed.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. When property is delivered to a common car-
2 rier, for transportation, and any person other than the con-
3 signor or consignee shall claim the title to such property
4 and shall forbid its transportation, he shall forthwith give
5 written notice to the carrier forbidding its transportation,
6 and thereupon the carrier shall be authorized to delay the
7 transportation for the space of five days, and unless within
8 such five days such claimant shall replevy such property, or
9 if he shall fail to give such written notice the carrier is
10 authorized to proceed with the transportation of such prop-
11 erty and shall not be liable for so transporting.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
