## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to the Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter sixty-nine of the Private

2 and Special Laws of 1869 is hereby amended by striking out 3 the word "ten" in the fifth line of said section and substitut-

3 the word ten in the fifth line of said section and substitute

4 ing therefor the words 'twenty-five,' so that said section as

5 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 2. Said society is established within and for the 7 towns of Monroe, Frankfort, Winterport, Prospect, Swans-8 ville, Brooks and Jackson in the county of Waldo and the 9 towns of Dixmont and Newburg in the county of Penobscot 10 and may take and hold property, real and personal, not

- 11 exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars, to be applied to the 12 advancement of agriculture and mechanic arts.'
  - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
