STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT for the protection of Fish in the West Outlet of Moosehead lake.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person shall take, catch, kill, fish for or
- 2 destroy any trout, land-locked salmon or other fish in the
- 3 west outlet of Moosehead lake from the first day of Octo-
- 4 ber to the eleventh day of August.
- Sect. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of
- 2 this act shall forfeit and pay the sum of twenty dollars for
- 3 the attempt and one dollar for each and every trout, land-
- 4 locked salmon or other fish so taken, caught, killed, or
- 5 destroyed, to be recovered by complaint.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
