STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT requiring Railroad Corporations to issue Mileage
Tickets at a Uniform Rate good for Passage of Bearer.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Every railroad corporation operating within
2 this State shall provide and have on sale, at a rate not exceed-
3 ing two cents per mile, mileage tickets representing one
4 thousand miles, or less, which shall be accepted and received
5 for fare and passage of the bearer of said mileage ticket, on
6 all lines of said corporation issuing the same.

Sect. 2. On petition of any railroad corporation included
2 within the provisions of this act, filed with the railroad com-
3 missioners asking that it may be exempt, said commissioners

4 may in their discretion exempt such railroad from the pro-
5 visions of this act, if in their judgment the public welfare or
6 financial condition of the railroad require or demand it.
