STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Skowhegan Electric Light Company to
Issue Bonds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Skowhegan Electric Light Company is
2 authorized to issue its bonds for the payment of its floating
3 debt and for extensions, additions and improvements to its
4 plant, at such rates of interest and on such time as it may
5 deem expedient, to an amount not exceeding one hundred
6 thousand dollars, and to secure same by a mortgage of the
7 franchises and property present and hereafter to be acquired of
8 said company.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
