STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT for the better protection of deer in the counties of
Cumberland, York and Sagadahoc.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever, in any manner or at any time within
2 four years of the approval of this act, shall hunt, chase, catch,
3 kill or destroy any deer within the counties of Cumberland,
4 Sagadahoc and York, forfeits forty dollars for each deer so
5 hunted, chased, killed or destroyed.

Sect. 2. All the provisions of chapter thirty of the Revised
2 Statutes relating to deer, not inconsistent with this act are hereby
3 made a part of this act.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
