STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter ninety-six of the laws of
the year 1887, providing for the extension of railroads.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section two of chapter ninety-six of the laws of the year 1887
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "state" in the
3 second line of said section the words 'or any railroad corpora-
4 tion organized under a special act of the legislature,' so that said
5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Any corporation formed under the general railroad
7 laws of this state or any railroad corporation organized under a
8 special act of the legislature, may be allowed to extend its road
9 to other points or places, on application to the board of rail-

10 road commissioners, as provided in section one of this act, and
11 by conforming to the general railroad laws of the state, so far
12 as the same may be applicable.'
