STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Charles T. Powers.

Resolved, That the land agent be and hereby is authorized and
2 directed to sell and convey to Charles T. Powers of Indian
3 Township No. 3, in Penobscot county, the premises now
4 occupied by him for a homestead, situated in said Indian Town-
5 ship No. 3, and being part of the reserved lands of said town-
6 ship, viz.: All of lot numbered 77 and all of lot numbered 78
7 lying westerly of Millinocket stream so called, the price for said
8 land not to exceed one dollar per acre, and the net proceeds of
9 said sale to be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of
10 the school fund of said township.
