### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter four hundred and fifty, Private Laws of 1893, relating to School Board of Eastport.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The school board of the city of Eastport shall 2 consist of three members, who shall be chosen by the city 3 council in the following manner, viz.: At the first meeting of 4 the city council after the passage of this act, three citizens of 5 the city, either male or female, shall be chosen to serve as 6 members of the school board, who shall hold office as provided

7 in section 2 of this act, and each succeeding year, the incoming

- 8 council shall at its first meeting choose one member of said 9 school board, who shall serve for three years to take the place 10 of the retiring member as provided in said section 2 of this 11 act, and all vacancies in said school board shall be filled by the 12 city council for the remainder of the term in which the same 13 occur.
- Sect. 2. The school board so chosen by the city council in 2 March, 1899, shall, at its first meeting, decide by lot, which of 3 its members shall serve for three years, which for two years, 4 and the remaining member shall serve for one year, and shall be 5 chairman of the board for that year; and each subsequent 6 year, the member whose term of office expires at the end of 7 that year, shall be the chairman of the board.
- Sect. 3. The school board chosen under this act shall have 2 all the powers, and perform all the duties of superintending 3 school committees, as provided in chapter eleven of the Revised 4 Statutes of 1883, and acts additional thereto and amendatory 5 thereof.
- Sect. 4. All the provisions of the law relating to public 2 schools in an act providing for a charter for the city of Eastport 3 and amendments thereto, inconsistent with the provisions of this 4 act, are hereby repealed.
  - Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
