STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to change time for holding Sessions of County
Commissioners in Washington County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section six, chapter seventy-eight of the Re-
vised Statutes is hereby amended, so far as it relates to hold-
ing annual sessions of the county commissioners in the
county of Washington, so that that part of said section shall
read as follows: 'Washington, at Machias, on the second
Tuesdays of January and October, and at Calais, on the
fourth Tuesday of April.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
