RESOLVE in favor of Repairing the Road between Patten and Grand Lake.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum

- 2 of thirteen hundred dollars to aid in repairing the road leading
- 3 from Patten, in Penobscot county, to Grand Lake. The same
- 4 to be expended upon that portion of the road which lies between
- 5 Shin Pond, so called, and Grand Lake. The same to be
- 6 expended under the direction of an agent to be appointed for
- 7 that purpose by the governor and council.
