STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of East Corinth Academy.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars yearly for two
2 years be and hereby is appropriated to East Corinth Academy,
3 an institution of learning, located in the town of Corinth, in
4 the county of Penobscot.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The amount appropriated by this resolve is the same as that received by the academy from the state for the past four years, and is necessary to enable the school to keep up its present standard of efficiency.
