STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Calais Academy.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and is here-2 by appropriated annually for two years to aid Calais academy;

- 3 provided, however, that this appropriation is made upon the
- 4 express condition that the trustees of said institution shall
- 5 maintain and keep in operation for at least twenty-four weeks
- 6 per year a school equal in rank and grade of teaching, with a
- 7 first class academy, and that if in the opinion of the governor
- 8 and council said institution shall fail to fulfill this condition
- 9 they may, in their discretion, withhold the appropriation herein
- 10 granted.
