## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making Appropriations for the Passamaquoddy  
Tribe of Indians.

---

*Resolved,* That there be paid from the State treasury to be  
2 expended under the direction of the governor and council to  
3 the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians, for the  
4 benefit of said tribe, for the years eighteen hundred and  
5 ninety-nine and nineteen hundred as follows:  
6 For May dividend, four hundred dollars each year.  
7 For November dividend, four hundred dollars each year.  
8 For distressed and contingent poor, three thousand five hun-  
9 dred dollars each year.  
10 For contingent purposes, one hundred and fifty dollars each  
11 year.

- 12 For bounty on crops, two hundred dollars each year.
- 13 For plowing, one hundred and fifty dollars each year.
- 14 For salary of governor, one hundred dollars each year.
- 15 For salary of lieutenant governor, forty dollars each year.
- 16 For wood, six hundred and fifty dollars each year.
- 17 For fertilizers, one hundred and fifty dollars each year.
- 18 For educational purposes, eight hundred dollars each year.
- 19 For salary of priests, two hundred dollars each year.
- 20 For salary of agent, two hundred dollars each year.
- 21 For basket ash, three hundred and fifty dollars each year.
- 22 For agricultural purposes, six hundred dollars each year.
- 23 For police, fifty dollars each year.
- 24 For school books, thirty dollars each year.
- 25 For painting schoolhouse at Pleasant Point, forty dollars in  
26 1899.
- 27 For repair and painting hall at Peter Dana's Point, fifty dol-  
28 lars in 1899.
- 29 For repair of road, Peter Dana's Point, one hundred dollars  
30 in 1899.
- 31 For repair of church building, Pleasant Point, two hundred  
32 and fifty dollars in 1899.
- 33 For over expenditures from last appropriations to be paid to  
34 agent of said tribe in the year 1899, forty-one dollars and  
35 ninety-nine cents.

All the foregoing sums to be expended under the direction  
37 of governor and council for the purposes for which they  
38 were appropriated and for none other, and any money not  
39 expended for the purposes for which it is appropriated, shall  
40 not be allowed to said agent in the settlement of his account.
