STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT requiring Railroad Corporations to issue Mileage Tickets at a Uniform Rate good for Passage of Bearer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Every railroad corporation operating, manag-

- 2 ing, or controlling any railroad of over fifty miles, which is
- 3 wholly or partly located within this State, shall provide and
- 4 have on sale at all principal stations on the line of its rail-
- 5 road within this State, at a rate not exceeding two cents
- 6 per mile, mileage tickets in the form of coupon books, of
- 7 convenient size, containing coupons representing one thou-
- 8 sand miles, or less, which shall be accepted and received for
- 9 fare and passage of the bearer of said mileage ticket, or per-
- to son presenting the same, on all lines of railroad within this

- 11 State of the corporation issuing the same; provided, how-12 ever, that no single passage shall be granted for less than 13 three mileage coupons.
 - Sect. 2. Every railroad corporation included within the 2 provisions of this act, violating any provision of section one 3 of this act shall be fined not less than one hundred nor more 4 than five hundred dollars, to be recovered on complaint, one-5 half to the complainant and balance to the county where the 6 offence is committed.
