STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT for protection of Fish in Bagaduce River, Bay and Tributaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. It shall be unlawful to take or fish for eels in any
- 2 manner whatever in the Bagaduce river, Bagaduce bay or any of
- 3 the tributaries of said river or bay between the first day of April
- 4 and the first day of November of each year.
 - Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of section
- 2 one of this act shall be punished by fine not exceeding ten dollars
- 3 or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days or both.
