STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES providing for the preservation of Regimental Rolls in
the Adjutant General's Office.

Resolved, That the adjutant general is hereby authorized and
2 directed under the advice and control of the governor and
3 council to provide for the preservation of the enlistment,
4 descriptive and muster rolls, and the monthly returns of the
5 regiments and batteries in the war of the rebellion, now on file
6 in the adjutant general's office.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand four hundred dollars
8 for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and two thou-
9 sand four hundred dollars for the year eighteen hundred and
10 ninety-eight is hereby appropriated for the preservation of said
11 rolls.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These resolves are substantially a renewal of the resolves approved March 25, 1897, of two thousand dollars for each of the years 1897 and 1898. It has been found that this appropriation carried the work of preserving the rolls of the organizations from this state serving in the war of the rebellion through a period of twenty months, making the cost two hundred dollars per month. The appropriation asked for is the amount estimated for the work that can be done in each full year.
