IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT Authorizing the Lewiston Trust and Safe Deposit Company to Establish a Branch at Lisbon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Lewiston Trust and Safe Deposit Company 2 is hereby authorized to establish a branch at Lisbon in the 3 county of Androscoggin.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
