IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to permit the Breeding and Raising of Quail for Purposes  
of Sale, by Henry J. Simpson of Sullivan, Maine.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Henry J. Simpson of Sullivan, Maine, is hereby  
2 authorized to breed quail in the town of Sullivan, for purpose  
3 of sale, at any time of the year, under such conditions and  
4 restrictions as may be imposed by the Commissioners of Inland  
5 Fisheries and Game; provided, however, that the Commissioners  
6 of Inland Fisheries and Game shall the right to purchase alive  
7 such quail as they may deem desirable for propagation in any  
8 part of the state where in their judgment they will increase.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
