STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to permit the Breeding and Raising of Quail for Purposes of Sale, by Henry J. Simpson of Sullivan, Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Henry J. Simpson of Sullivan, Maine, is hereby

- 2 authorized to breed quail in the town of Sullivan, for purpose
- 3 of sale, at any time of the year, under such conditions and
- 4 restrictions as may be imposed by the Commissioners of Inland
- 5 Fisheries and Game; provided, however, that the Commissioners
- 6 of Inland Fisheries and Game shall the right to purchase alive
- 7 such quail as they may deem desirable for propagation in any
- 8 part of the state where in their judgment they will increase.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
