STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to legalize and make valid the meeting and doings of the corporation known as The Trustees of the Charity Fund of Caribou Lodge, so called at Caribou, in the County of Aroostook in the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The corporation known as The Trustees of the
2 Charity Fund of Caribou Lodge, located at Caribou, in the
3 county of Aroostook and State of Maine, and consisting of
4 members of Caribou Lodge, number one hundred and seventy,
5 free and accepted masons, of said Caribou, is hereby declared
6 to be a legal, valid and existing corporation, and the meeting
7 of said corporation held at said Caribou on the first day of

8 December, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, is declared to be
9 a legal and valid meeting, legally called and legally held, and
10 the doings of said meeting, as shown by the records thereof,
11 are hereby approved, ratified, and declared to be valid and
12 legal.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
