## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to Acts to Incorporate the Lockwood Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The Lockwood Company, a corporation estab-
- 2 lished by law and having its place of business at Waterville,
- 3 in the county of Kennebec, is hereby allowed to increase its
- 4 capital stock from two million dollars to two million five hun-
- 5 dred thousand dollars.
- Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized and empow-
- 2 ered to purchase, hold or lease any real and personal estate
- 3 essential to or convenient for its business, and also to acquire,
- 4 hold and dispose of the shares of the capital stock of other
- 5 corporations.

Sect. 3. Chapter 460 of the Private and Special Laws of 2 1874, establishing said corporation, as amended by chapter 3 182 of the Private and Special Laws of 1875, is hereby 4 amended by inserting the words 'or elsewhere' after the word 5 "Winslow" in the second line of the second section thereof.
