STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to Acts to Incorporate the Lockwood Com-
pany.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Lockwood Company, a corporation estab-
lished by law and having its place of business at Waterville,
in the county of Kennebec, is hereby allowed to increase its
capital stock from two million dollars to two million five hun-
dred thousand dollars.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized and empow-
ered to purchase, hold or lease any real and personal estate
essential to or convenient for its business, and also to acquire,
hold and dispose of the shares of the capital stock of other
corporations.

Sect. 3. Chapter 460 of the Private and Special Laws of
2 1874, establishing said corporation, as amended by chapter
3 182 of the Private and Special Laws of 1875, is hereby
4 amended by inserting the words 'or elsewhere' after the word
5 "Winslow" in the second line of the second section thereof.
