## STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Public Works Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Public Works Company is hereby author-2 ized to convey to Indian Island in the Penobscot river a sup-3 ply of pure water for domestic, manufacturing and municipal 4 purposes, with all the rights, powers and privileges, and sub-5 ject to all the duties, restrictions and liabilities contained in 6 the charter of said company and acts amendatory thereof.

Sect. 2. For the purposes aforesaid the said company is 2 authorized to lay, construct and maintain its mains and pipes 3 under, in and across the Penobscot river and to build and 4 maintain all necessary structures therefor; all to be done at 5 such places as may be necessary for said purposes and not to 6 obstruct the public use of said river.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
