STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE Making Appropriations for the Penobscot Tribe of
Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the State treasury to
2 the agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians for the years
3 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and nineteen hundred, to
4 be appropriated for the benefit of said tribe, each year, as
5 follows: Forty-four hundred and twenty-nine dollars and
6 seventy cents, amount of interest on their trust fund held
7 by the State for the benefit of said tribe. For agricultural
8 purposes, eight hundred and fifty dollars each year; for
9 bounty on crops, two hundred dollars each year; for annuity,
10 seventeen hundred dollars each year; for salary of agent,
11 four hundred dollars each year; for instruction in agricul-
12 ture, fifty dollars each year; for schools, six hundred dollars
13 each year; for salary of governor, fifty dollars each year;

14 for salary of lieutenant governor, forty dollars each year ;
15 for salary of Roman Catholic Priest, one hundred dollars
16 each year ; for cemetery fence, fifty dollars for year 1899 ;
17 for school house, two hundred dollars for year 1899 ; for
18 municipal purposes, ten per cent. each year of the shore
19 rentals.
