# STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to incorporate the South West Harbor Dam and Bridge Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Charles E. Cook, Henry Clark, Walter Stanley, J. B. Mason, 2 A. I. Holmes, Geo. Harman, Joseph D. Phillips, Geo. R. Ful-3 ler, S. W. Herrick, Pedrick D. Gilley, Robie M. Norwood, 4 Jr., Geo. E. Street, Cyrus Lurvey, Stephen M. Gilley, their - associates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a body 6 corporate by the name of the South West Harbor Dam and 7 Bridge Company, for the purpose of building, erecting and 8 maintaining a dam or breakwater across the mouth or out-9 let of Norwood's cove in tide waters, in the town of Tremont,

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10 county of Hancock, and State of Maine, at such place as said II corporation may deem convenient and practicable, near the 12 site of the old mill dam, near the mouth or outlet of said Nor-13 wood's cove and extending such distance above or below the 14 high tides as may be desirable, with an opening therein with 15 such tide gates and locks, if any, as may be required to let the 16 tide waters into and retain the same in said Norwood's cove. 17 Said dam or breakwater to be constructed of such size and 18 material and in such manner as said company may determine. 19 Said corporation may construct and maintain a bridge across 20 the outlet or mouth of said Norwood's cove in tide waters, 21 said bridge shall have a draw of such width as the county 22 commissioners shall approve. Said company may occupy 23 any land necessary for its dam or breakwater and bridge, 24 piers and abutments for its construction and maintenance. 25 It may enter upon such land to make surveys and locations, 26 and shall file in the registry of deeds of Hancock, plans of 27 such location and lands and within thirty days thereafter, 28 publish notice thereof in some newspaper in said county, such 29 publication to be continued three weeks successively. 30 Should the said company and the owner of such land be 31 unable to agree upon damages to be paid for such location, 32 occupation and construction, the land owner may, within two 33 years after filing of plans of location, apply to the commis-34 sioners of said county and have such damages assessed as is 35 provided by law in cases wherein land is taken by railroads. 36 Failure to apply for damages within said two years shall be 37 held as a waiver of the same. Said company for all its said 38 purposes mayhold real and personal estate sufficient, necessary

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39 and convenient therefor. The capital stock of said company
40 shall be four thousand dollars and shall bedivided in shares of
41 fifty dollars each. The first meeting of said corporation may
42 be called by a notice signed by any two of the corporators,
43 posted for five days before the day fixed for the meeting, in
44 the post office in the village of South West Harbor, in said
45 town of Tremont.

This act shall take effect when approved.
