STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to Legalize the Doings of Rangeley Plantation in
Franklin County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The election and qualification of the officers of
2 Rangeley Plantation in Franklin county at its last annual
3 meeting in A. D. 1898, are hereby confirmed, legalized and
4 made valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
