STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 126 of the Public Laws of 1895.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and twenty-six (126) of 2 the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five is 3 hereby amended by striking out the word "twenty" in the 4 third line of section one of said chapter, and inserting in lieu 5 thereof the word 'twelve' also by striking out the word "ten" 6 in line five and line six and insert in lieu thereof the word 7 'six' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section I. A tribal committee of the Penobscot tribe of 9 Indians shall be chosen annually in the month of November 10 to consist of twelve members of said tribe. No member of 11 said committee shall be less than twenty-one years of age. 12 Six members thereof shall be chosen by the old party, so

13 called, and six members thereof by the new party, so called,14 at separate meetings holden as hereinafter provided.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect at the annual election to2 be holden in the month of November in the year of our Lord,3 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.
