IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to Incorporate the Ticonic Foot Bridge Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. William T. Haines and Harvey D. Eaton with
2 their associates and successors are hereby constituted a body
3 corporate by the name of the Ticonic Foot Bridge Company,
4 for the purpose of erecting and keeping in repair, a foot
5 bridge over the Kennebec river from the easterly end of Tem-
6 ple street in Waterville to the oppositeshore in Winslow. Said
7 corporation shall have power to take and hold such real estate
8 as may be necessary to carry into effect said object and to
9 make all needful rules and regulations governing the use

10 of said bridge and shall have and enjoy all the powers and
11 privileges incident to similar corporations.

Sect. 2. Compensation for all lands taken or damages
2 caused by said corporation shall be determined on petition of
3 interested parties by the county commissioners of Kennebec
4 county in the same manner as damages are assessed for the
5 laying out of highways.

Sect. 3. Said bridge shall be constructed of good materials,
2 of a suitable height from the water and with sufficient rail-
3 ing for the safety of passengers.

Sect. 4. A toll is hereby granted and established for the
2 benefit of said corporation, not exceeding two cents for each
3 foot passenger crossing said bridge, and the provisions of
4 section one of chapter 50 of the Revised Statutes shall apply
5 to said corporation.

Sect. 5. Said corporation may issue stock to an amount
2 not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars and may issue
3 bonds not exceeding the amount of stock issued.

Sect. 6. If said corporation shall neglect or refuse for a
2 term of five years from the passage of this act to build and
3 complete said bridge, this act shall be null and void.
