STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Record of Contracts for the Sale of Land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Any written contract for the sale of real estate 2 or any interest therein, whether under seal or not and 3 whether acknowledged or not, may be recorded in the registry of deeds in the registry district in the county in which 5 the land is situated, and the record thereof shall be notice of 6 the contracts of such contract as in case of deeds. Any 7 assignment of such contract may be recorded with like effect.

The fee of the register for record shall be the same as for 9 the record of a deed.

Sect. 2. When such contract from any cause ceases to be 2 obligatory, the vendee or his assignee, shall discharge the 3 same upon the record upon demand of any person interested 4 in the land and if he refuses or neglects to do so the record 5 may be discharged by decree of court in equity.
