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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

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AN ACT to set off certain Lands from Oxford Village Corporation.

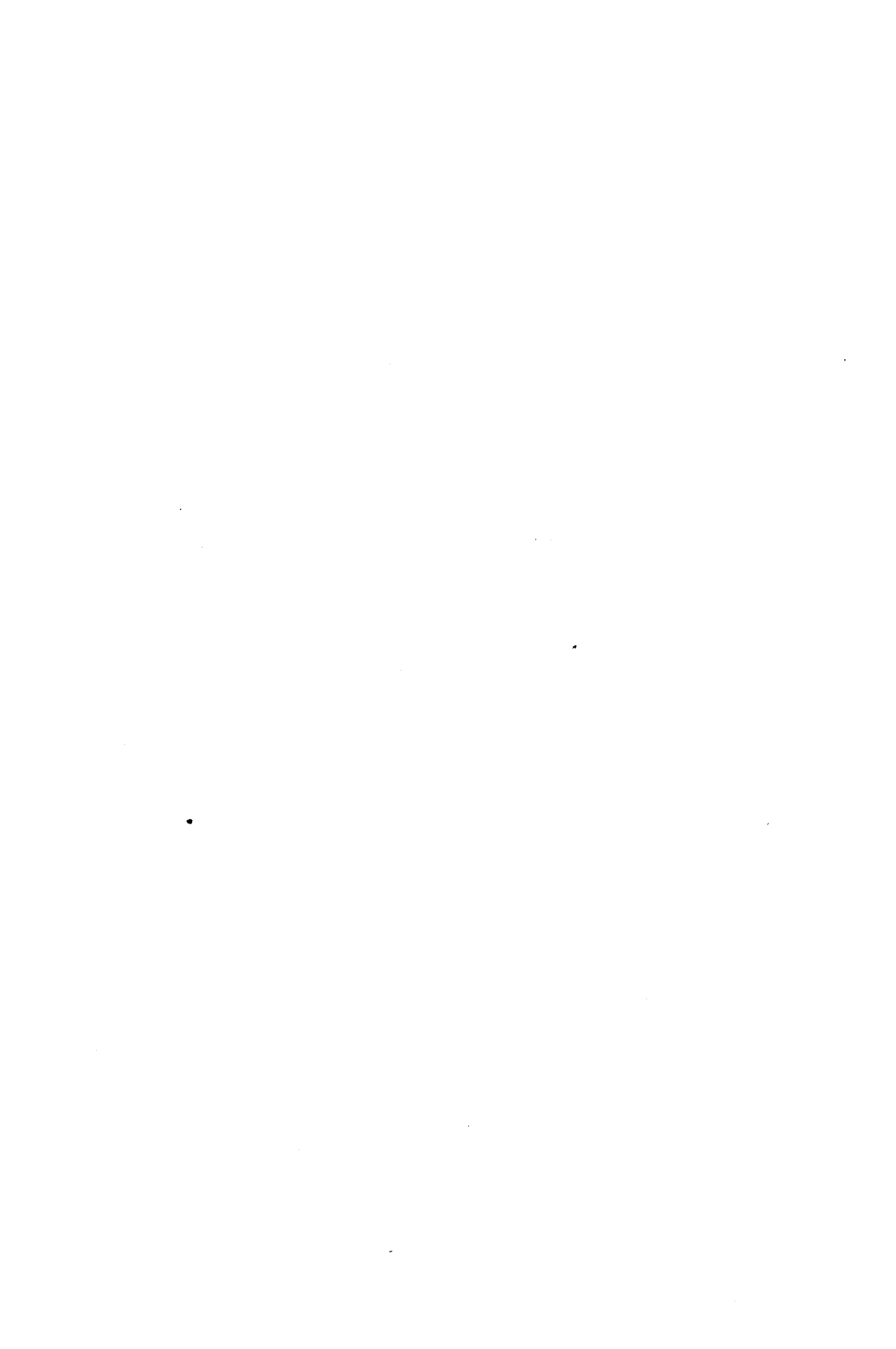
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The respective farms of John B. Robinson known  
2 as the Highland farm and those now occupied by Frank L.  
3 Manson, Samuel C. Wardwell and Hannah C. Morse as home-  
4 steads and the farm lately occupied by Cyrus T. Wardwell as  
5 a homestead, are hereby set off from the Oxford Village  
6 Corporation.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
