AN ACT to set off certain Lands from Oxford Village Corporation.


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The respective farms of John B. Robinson known

- 2 as the Highland farm and those now occupied by Frank L.
- 3 Manson, Samuel C. Wardwell and Hannah C. Morse as home-
- 4 steads and the farm lately occupied by Cyrus T. Wardwell as
- 5 a homestead, are hereby set off from the Oxford Village
- 6 Corporation.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
