STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT authorizing the Hallowell Granite Works to lay and maintain pipes in the City of Hallowell for the use and distribution of compressed air.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Hallowell Granite Works, a corporation 2 organized under the general laws of the State of Maine, is 3 hereby authorized to erect, maintain and operate works for 4 the purpose of compressing air, and of storing, using, dis-5 tributing and supplying the same for power and other pur-6 poses in the city of Hallowell, and to hold such real estate, 7 personal property and patent rights as may be necessary 8 therefor.

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Sect. 2. Said company is hereby authorized for the pur-2 poses aforesaid to lay down and maintain in, under, through, 3 along and across any water course, stream, bridge, street, 4 highway or other way situated between the company's quar-5 ries in the western part of said city and the company's wharf 6 on the west bank of the Kennebec river in said city, such 7 mains and pipes as may be necessary for the purposes afore-8 said, and to enter upon and dig up any road, street, highway 9 or other way for the purpose of laying such mains and pipes 10 beneath the surface thereof, and for maintaining, replacing 11 and repairing the same, and in general, may do any other 12 acts and things necessary, convenient or proper for the com-13 plete establishment, maintenance and operation of its said 14 works and plant; provided, however, that said company shall 15 at its own expense and to the satisfaction of the city council 16 of said city, without unnecessary delay, repair said streets, 17 highways and other ways in every part where they shall be 18 entered upon and dug up and restore the covering, paving 19 and sidewalks thereof respectively.

Sect. 3. Said company shall be liable in all cases to repay 2 said city all sums of money that said city may be obliged to 3 pay on any judgment recovered against said city for dam-4 ages occasioned by any obstruction or taking up of any street, 5 highway or other way, in said city by said company, together 6 with fees of counsel and other expenses incurred in defending 7 the same, provided, however, that said company shall have 8 reasonable notice of any suit whenever such damages may be 9 claimed, and shall be allowed to defend the same at its own 10 expense.

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Sect. 4. Said company may lay and maintain mains and 2 pipes for the purposes aforesaid under and across any rail-3 road, but in case of failure to agree with such railroad com-4 pany as to place, manner and conditions of crossing its rail-5 road with such mains and pipes, the place, manner and con-6 ditions of such crossing shall be determined by the railroad 7 commissioners, and all work within the limits of the railroad 8 locations shall be done under the supervision and to the sat-9 isfaction of the officers and agents of the railroad company 10 but at the expense of said Hallowell Granite Works.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
