STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of Repairing the Bridge across the Narraguagus river in the town of Milbridge.

Resolved, That the sum of four hundred dollars for the 2 year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and four hundred 3 dollars for the year nineteen hundred, be and is hereby 4 appropriated, to aid in repairing a bridge across the Nar-5 raguagus river in the town of Milbridge, said bridge to be 6 repaired under the direction of the county commissioners of 7 Washington county, and the amounts herein appropriated 8 are to be paid when the governor and council are satisfied 9 that the sum of sixteen hundred dollars has been actually 10 expended for repairs of said bridge by the town of Milbridge.
